Guest Lectures/Invited Talk

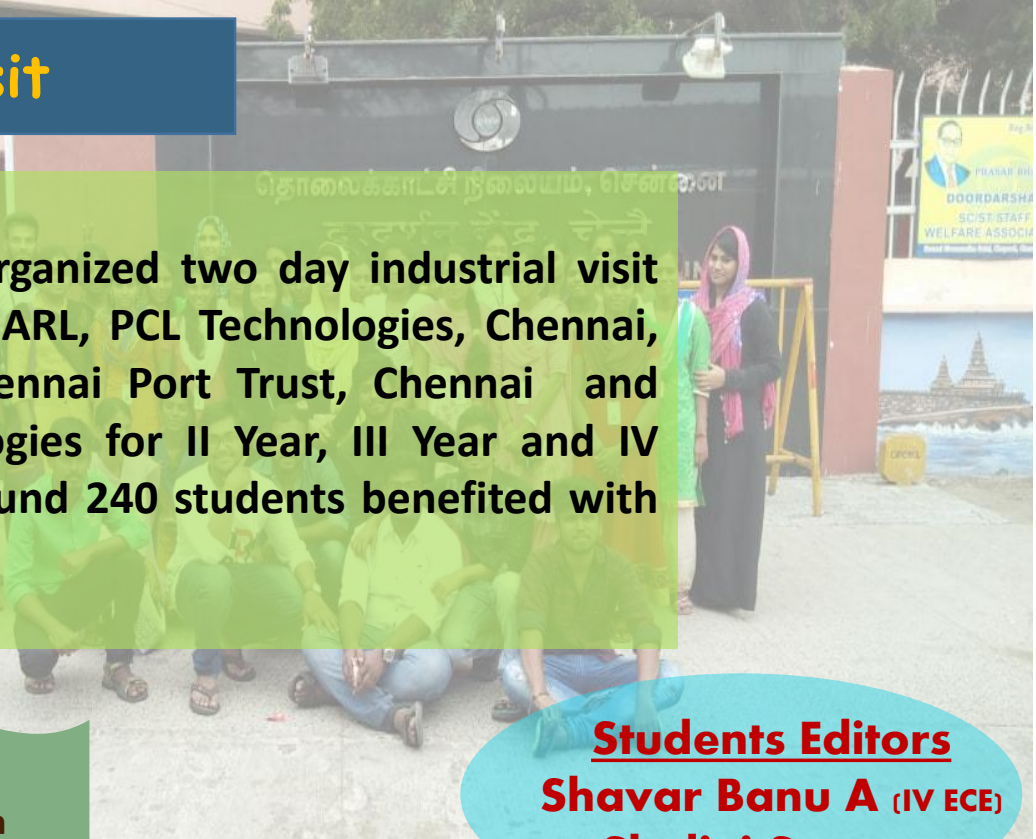
